All Games played to a result.

All duties must be carried out (penalties applies)

Use rubbish bins provided and grooms are to clear away tape and manure around their trucks

Penalties for not doing duties may include \$200 fine

Team Captains are responsible for team duties.

Helmets to be worn by all riders.

Beware at all times of horses and polo balls

Alcohol consumption by Umpires and Goal Umpires is not permitted.

No under age or unlicensed drivers or riders on premises

Riding or driving of motorised vehicles by unlicensed drivers or riders is strictly prohibited

Entry to the polo grounds is at your own risk

All spectators and grooms are to remain ten (10) metres from the sideline.

Parking on ground at own risk

Trucks to park in designated zones.

No unauthorised vehicles on the playing surface or within the safety zone.

If goal umpires are not experienced please contact tournament committee for a briefing
